The new motor for the roller came in and is sitting at the barn waiting for a rainy day.

The lakes got treated last week. I will need to buy more lake chemicals before we treat again.

J.P. Morgan Chase got the financing for the trash truck done. Loan papers are ready and waiting on the truck to come in. It is supposed to be in the 2~' to 3~ week of May. The billing for trash will go out around the 2mu~ week of ~ The fliers and route map in your packets will go out with the 1st billing.

We hauled 7 loads of sand to the beach from the silt basin on Brande Dr. A camera system was placed at Maintenance barn. It works good. I will remind people there will be a stiff fine for dumping trash.

Wow, next year there will be a line item for American flags. These things are expensive and we have a lot of them scattered around 7 locations. The one at the dam cost \$25 and needs to be replaced about 10 to 12 times a year. The one at the mall is \$50 and is replaced about 4 or 5 times a year, making the annual cost for flags about \$500 to \$700 per year.

We have been working on the bridge at the spillway all week. The old concrete was chipped and cleaned up. The rebar was primed and painted. Then, we started patching the concrete back in and we will do the repairs to the other bridge over Paint Creek. It is not near as bad off as the bridge over spillway.

The patrol boat motor will have to go to shop this week if I can't figure out its problem Monday or Tuesday.
