LIGHTS REQUIRED ON ALL POWERED WATERCRAFT

All powered watercraft underway are required to display navigation lights between sunset and sunrise. They consist of red and green running lights on the bow and a white all-around light on the stern. (Docking lights should not be used unless necessary.) Watercraft with manual propulsion must display a white light.

No-Wake goes into effect 1/2 hour before sunset. Also PWCs (Jetski, Seadoo etc.) must be off the lake at this time.
