Spring and the May garage sales are just around the corner which means it's time to start cleaning out the garage and shed to make room for the that summer project you have been thinking about all winter long. After cleaning all day on a Saturday afternoon are you finding yourself surrounded by trash? But stop right there it may not be trash, it could be recyclables!

The LPOA Board would like to remind every resident to recycle as much as possible to help keep our landfill clean for many years to come. Also why not get rewarded for recycling? All you need to do is obtain a red Rumpke recycling bin by either picking one up at the LPOA office or emailing m_brueggemann@lpoa.org and request a bin to be dropped off at your residence. Then within a few days one will be delivered to your residence and you will be ready to start recycling.

To be eligible for the rewards program all you need to do is set out a red Rumpke bin at the end of your driveway on Sunday evening for a Monday pickup. The LWA Committee will then randomly scout for a resident that "has been caught recycling" the chosen resident then has to contact the LPOA office to choose their reward which ranges from discounts on LPOA bills, gift certificates, fuel cards, discount certificates to Lakengren Inn etc.

Ski Club Saying Good By & Thanks to All By Rhonda Smith

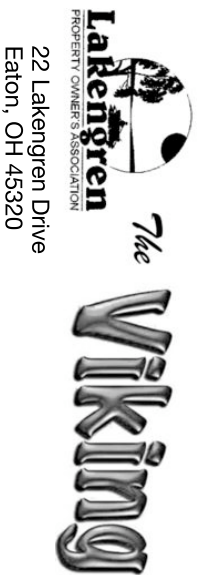
