The Marina siding is on and looks good. I hope to get it open next week on the 15. There is a couple of pieces of trim missing but this will not stop the Marina from opening.

The walking path is moving along across the dam. A small portion is complete.

To rebuild the front axle of the backhoe, an estimate without having it looked at is about \$2,000 to \$2,200. Rental for a backhoe to use during the front axle rebuild for two weeks is \$1,550.00. The total for the rebuild and rental will cost us \$3,700 to \$4,000.

A new reach in freezer has been purchased for the Lodge kitchen. The old freezer was for household use and not commercial use and as a result did not operate properly.

The 2009 payment/registration process went pretty smooth this year thanks to all the members who mailed or dropped off their completed registration packets at the Lakengren Office. The office staff continues to process the 2009 registration packets and should be done by the end of next week.
